Autumn is a season.



Autumn is the time of year when leaves change colour and fall from the trees.



There are four seasons. They are spring, summer, autumn and winter.



Some animals collect food ready for winter. Squirrels collect nuts, such as acorns, which they bury underground until they need them.



In autumn the weather starts to get colder and the days get shorter.



Some animals, like hedgehogs, get ready to hibernate. This means they will sleep through the cold winter.
