What I know and can explain

Shape is one of the seven elements of art

Shapes are created using a line to create an enclosed two-dimensional space

Pattern is one of the visual elements of art

Colours can be used to make patterns

Texture is one of the seven visual elements of art. A texture can be described as rough, smooth, wrinkly, soft, sharp, spiky, shiny and bumpy

Yayoi Kusama is a Japanese contemporary artist who makes large-scale sculptures of natural forms. Her work is often brightly coloured and highly patterned

Useful Vocabulary

Colour - The hue or shade of something

Contemporary artist - An artist who is living at this time

Form - The 3-D shape of something

Line - A mark made in drawing

Pattern - A decorative design

Sculpture - A 3-D form

Shape - The outline of something

Visual element - A characteristic that can be seen, such as line, shape, form, colour, pattern and texture
