### Year 2 – Cut, Stitch and Join



In this topic, we will be learning about fabrics along with methods of joining two pieces using a running stitch before making a final product.

#### What I know and can explain

There are many home products made from fabric

Properties of components and materials determine how they can and cannot be used

A running stitch is a basic stitch used to join two pieces of fabric

The Cath Kidston brand was an important British brand which began in the 1990s

A brand is a name, term, design, or symbol identifying a seller's products or services

#### Useful Vocabulary

**Appliqué** - Decorative needlework in which pieces of fabric are sewn or stuck onto a larger piece to form a pattern

**Binca** – The trade name given to a form of embroidery canvas that has lots of holes and is used to practice sewing

**Embellishment** – A decorative feature added to something to make it more attractive, such as sequins, applique, buttons or motifs

**Motif** - An image or design that can be repeated to create a pattern

**Running stitch** – a simple stitch which involves regular up and down movements to form a dashed line

**Sequin** - A small, shiny metal or plastic disc

**Textile** - A fabric made by hand or machine
