### Year 1 – Animal Parts



In this topic, we will be learning about animals including fish, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will learn about features they have in common.

#### What I know and can explain

Animals are living things

Different animal groups have some common body parts

Fish, reptiles, birds and mammals are groups of animals

Living things need water, food, warmth and shelter

Carnivores eat other animals (meat), herbivores eat plants and omnivores eat other animals and plants

#### Useful Vocabulary

**Animal** - A living thing that grows, breathes, eats, moves, gets rid of waste and has offspring

**Camouflage** - The ability to hide or blend in with the surroundings

**Carnivore** - An animal that only eats meat

**Herbivore** - An animal that only eats plants

**Human** - A mammal with two arms and two legs that walks in an upright position

**Mammal** - An animal that has fur or hair and four limbs

**Omnivore** - An animal that eats both meat and plants

**Reptile** - An animal that has dry, scaly skin and has either four legs or no legs
